## The Equal Opportunities Commission

The Equal Opportunities Commission is a statutory body set up in 1996 to implement the Sex Discrimination Ordinance, the Disability Discrimination Ordinance and the Family Status Discrimination Ordinance. The Commission works towards the elimination of discrimination on the grounds of sex, marital status, pregnancy, disability and family status. We also aim to eliminate sexual harassment, and harassment and vilification on the ground of disability. We promote equality of opportunities between men and women, between persons with and without a disability and irrespective of family status.
