Asia and the Pacific

Cambodia

10 days' special leave for family events

Indonesia

Two days' paid when wife gives birth

Myanmar

Six days of "casual leave" that can be used by fathers to assist their spouses at the time of

confinement

New

Two weeks of unpaid paternity leave

Zealand

Philippines

Seven days' paid paternity leave for married workers

Saudi Arabia One day of paid leave

Africa

Algeria

Three days' paid paternity leave

Cameroon

Up to 10 days' paid leave for family events concerning workers' home

Chad

Up to 10 days' paid leave for family events concerning workers' home

Côte d'Ivoire Up to 10 days' paid leave for family events concerning workers' home

Diibouti

10 days' family-related leave

Ethiopia

Five days of unpaid leave in the event of exceptional or serious events

Gabon

Up to 10 days' paid leave for family events concerning workers' home

Madagascar

10 days of unpaid leave for family events

Rwanda

Two days' paternity leave

Seychelles

Four days of paid leave for "compassionate reasons"

South Africa Three days' paid family responsibility leave

Togo

Up to ten days of paid leave for "family events directly related to home"

Tunisia

Paternity leave of I day (private sector), 2 days' (public sector)

Americas

Argentina

Two days' paid paternity leave

Bahamas

One week family-related leave

Brazil

Seven days' paid paternity leave

Chile

One day of paid paternity leave

Guatemala Paraguay

Two days at birth of child Two days' paid paternity leave

Uruguay

Three days paternity leave for civil servants

Europe

Denmark

14 days' paid paternity leave + Two weeks' paid parental leave reserved for the father

Estonia

14 calendar days'

Finland

18 days' paid paternity leave

France

Two weeks' paid paternity leave

Hungary

Five days' paternity leave

Iceland

Three months paid paternity leave

Italy

Two weeks' paid paternity leave

Latvia

10 calendar days'

Norway

Two weeks' unpaid paternity leave + Four weeks' paid parental leave reserved for the father

Portugal

Five days' paternity leave

Romania

Five days' paid paternity leave

Slovenia

90 days' paid paternity leave

Sweden

10 days' paid paternity leave + 2 months paid parental leave reserved for the father

Turkey

Three days' paternity leave in the public sector

UK

Two weeks' paid paternity leave

Note: The table accounts for leave provisions reserved for fathers and does not include sharable leave provisions.
