Chairperson of the Equal Opportunities Commission

Ms Linda LAM Mei-sau has been the Chairperson of the Equal Opportunities Commission (EOC) since 11 April 2024. She takes charge of the EOC's efforts to eliminate discrimination through the enforcement of the anti-discrimination ordinances and promote equality of opportunities and the value of inclusion in the community.



Before joining the EOC, Ms Lam had a distinguished career in the Department of Justice that spanned 29 years. She was appointed Crown Counsel in 1994 and had worked in different legal divisions of the Department, during which she had advised the government on a wide range of subjects from the perspectives of criminal, civil and international law. She was promoted through the ranks to become Principal Government Counsel in 2018. In 2021, she was appointed Law Officer and held the position of Law Officer (International Law) until her retirement from the Civil Service.

Ms Lam was called to the English Bar (Gray's Inn) and the Hong Kong Bar in 1991. She was also admitted as an advocate and solicitor in Singapore in 1993.
