- We should avoid prejudice or making assumptions based solely on a person’s appearance.
- As the old saying goes, “Don’t judge a book by its cover”. We shouldn’t judge a person solely on his/her appearance.
- To assess a person objectively, we need to understand his/her character and acts, not just by their looks.

2. If you were an octopus-like alien and encountered discriminatory attitudes from others, how would you feel?

- Anger, sadness, frustration, fear, humiliation, confusion, injustice, loss of self-esteem, etc.
- Understand the negative impact of discrimination or unfair treatment, and will try to avoid such act.
